EVENT OVERVIEW

HOW WILL THE WALK WORK?

Each day there will be a bus transfer from the Kids Under Cover Office on Swan Street, Richmond to the start point in the morning and back from the finish point each afternoon (Day 4 excluded). Walkers are welcome to accommodate themselves along the route and make their own way to the start point each morning.

Each morning you will register with the event team at the start point to collect your Walk for Cover Pack which includes:

- Walk for Cover branded t-shirt
- Walk for Cover branded hi-vis vest (these will be collected from walkers each evening)
- Kids Under Cover branded water bottle
- Kids Under Cover branded cap
- Event lanyard with route details and key contacts
- Supplies for the road (snacks, sun screen etc)

Please note: if you are walking multiple days, be sure to bring your pack with you as each walker will only receive 1 pack.

Each morning there will be a compulsory safety briefing for all walkers. This will include; an introduction to the Support Crew, information about the route and weather for that day, and any other specific safety information needed.

If you are walking multiple days, we will still require you to sign in each day at registration and attend each morning's safety briefing.

Each day you will be provided with morning tea, lunch and evening refreshments. Sunday and Monday include afternoon activations with food provided (please see breakdown below for further information on these days).

- Filtered water will be provided to fill up your Kids Under Cover Water Bottle.
- There are toilets located along the route.

In the event of an emergency, the group are accompanied by an experienced Support Crew who will ensure your safety.

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WHO IS YOUR SUPPORT CREW?

Kids Under Cover have engaged Perfect Events to assist with the management of the event, Walk for Cover.

Perfect Events has extensive experience in producing large scale events including multi-day walks similar to this.

Members of your Support Crew will include:

- Kids Under Cover team
- Perfect Events team
- First Aid
- Safety Officer
- Security (on Day 4)

This Support Crew will accompany you in vehicles and on the ground that will lead and follow behind the group (Top and Tail Cars).

Support Vehicles include; 2x Lead cars, as well as, 2x Tail 12-seater vans.

The tail vans will be equipped with food and water for walkers and will also be a mobile resting space for anyone needing a break from walking.

There will be space to transport luggage and your belongings for you to access during the breaks, however, if you are planning on staying in accommodation along the route and will therefore have luggage please let us know ahead of time so that we can ensure there is enough space for everyone.

DAY 1: ROSEBUD TO FRANKSTON

Notes for Day 1:

There are some parts of the road that are unsafe for you to walk, therefore the group will be transferred by bus past these points.

Timing is approx. based on the walking speed of the group. If the group arrives at any stopping point early or late, times will be adjusted accordingly.

9.00am	Walk Rosebud Pier (Jetty Road) to car park opposite the corner of Marine Drive and Victoria Street (Safety Beach) 9km (approx. 2.5 hours)

12.00pm	Bus transfer from Car park opposite the Corner of Marine Drive and Victoria Street, Safety Beach to Morrisons Ave Car Park (Mount Martha) (approx. 10 mins)
12.15pm	Walk Morrisons Ave Car Park (Mount Martha) to Rotunda in Mornington Park (Mornington) 5km (approx. 1.5 hours)
1.45pm	Lunch break and hear from Gabriele (KUC Carer - Q & A) (approx. 45 mins)
2.45pm	Bus transfer from Mornington Park (Mornington) to Peninsula Vet Care (Mt Eliza) (approx. 8 mins)
3.00pm	Walk Rupert White Reserve to Frankston Foreshore Reserve 7.5km (approx. 2 hours)
4.30pm	Walkers arrive at end point for Day 1.
4.30pm– 5.30pm	Evening refreshments – grazing nibbles and beverages while we debrief from the day
5.30pm	Hi-vis vests collected by event staff
6.15pm	Bus transfer leave Frankston Foreshore Stops at: Beaumaris Yacht Club
7.30pm	Bus arrives at Kids Under Cover office.

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DAY 2: FRANKSTON TO BEAUMARIS

Notes for Day 2:

Timing is approx. based on the walking speed of the group. If the group arrives at any stopping point early or late, times will be adjusted accordingly.

11.30am	Walk Old Carrum Life Saving Club to Peter Scullin Reserve (Mordialloc) 8.7km (approx. 2 hours)
1.30pm	Lunch break (approx. 45 mins – 1 hour)
2.30pm	Walk Peter Scullin Reserve (Mordialloc) to Beaumaris Yacht Club 6.7km (approx. 1.5 hours)
4.00pm	Walkers arrive at end point for Day 2.
4.00pm– 5.30pm	Evening refreshments – grazing nibbles and beverages while we debrief from the day and hear from Ali (KUC Young person)
5.30pm	Hi-vis vests collected by event staff
5.45pm	Bus transfer leaves Beaumaris
6.45pm	Bus arrives at Kids Under Cover office.

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DAY 3: BEAUMARIS TO CATANI GARDENS

1.00pm	Lunch break (approx. 45 mins – 1 hour)
2.00pm	Walk Elwood Beach/ Life Saving Club to Catani Gardens (St Kilda) 3.5km (approx. 1.5 hour)
3.00pm	Catani Gardens Family Day Activation Live for Family arrival

9.00am – 9.30am	Walker registration and safety briefing
9.30am	Walk commences
9.30am	Walk Albert Park to Yarra Yarra Rowing Club 2.8km (approx. 1 hour)
10.30am	Meet other walkers and dignitaries at Rowing Club
10.30am	Morning tea (30 mins)
11.15am	Walk Yarra Yarra Rowing Club to Parliament House (via Swanston St and Bourke St) (approx. 45 mins)
12.00pm	Group arrives at Parliament House for formalities on the steps and group photo (approx. 30 mins)
12.30pm	Walk Parliament House to Kids Under Cover 3.8 km (approx. 1.5 hours)
1.30pm	Thank You Event commences at Kids Under Cover's office in Richmond.
2.00pm	Walkers arrive at Kids Under Cover office. Welcomed by Kids Under Cover, Walk for Cover teams and supporters.
2.30pm–5.30pm	Food and beverage for guests along with entertainment and presentations.
